

Canadian Centre of Academic Art and Science (CCAAS): Statement of Copyright and Author Rights for *Architectoni.ca* Journal

We carry various activities to ensure maximum access to authors' articles and articles' citations. Work together with authors and other partnerships, we are also seeking to constantly improve the journal's reputation, its editorial board, and the accumulated value carried on by the journal and the CCAAS publisher.

Transfer of Publishing Right

Submission of an article will automatically transfer the exclusive publishing right to CCAAS. This automatic publishing right transfer is applied to all authors. If the article is not accepted for publication the copyright will be released to the authors. The publishing right transfer covers the exclusive rights to reproduce and distribute the article in any format and in all languages for the full term of copyright. This includes reprints, photographic reproductions, microfilm or any other reproductions of similar nature and translations. Authors are responsible for obtaining from the copyright holder permission to reproduce any figures for which copyright exists.

The rights that you retain as Author

In granting an exclusive publishing right, the authors always retain the right to be identified as authors of the article wherever the article is published, the patent rights, trademark rights, and Industrial design rights or rights to any products, designs, and other inventions presented in the article. In additions, the authors also retain the following rights:

1. If your article is published with open-access as noticed by the editor, the right to post the entire article on your own website, or on other platforms, on the following condition: 1) with proper accreditation of the source and original publisher as following: This article is published in the journal of *Architectoni.ca* © [year of publication], copyright CCAAS. The journal is available online at <http://ccaasmag.org/ARCH>. 2) not allowed for commercial uses.
2. If your article is published with non-open access, the right to post only the title and abstract of the article on your own website, or on other platforms.
3. the right to present the article at a meeting/conference or lecture in classroom. The printed copies of the article can be distributed to the attendances provided that such copies are not offered for sale or distributed in any systematic way, and provided that acknowledgement to prior publication in the *Architectoni.ca* journal © CCAAS is made explicit;

4. the right to include the article in a thesis or dissertation of an author that is not to be published commercially, provided that acknowledgement to prior publication in the *Architectoni.ca* journal © CCAAS is made explicit;

5. the right to re-produce or use the article in its published form with or without revisions in other publications of an author's own articles or books, provided that acknowledgement to prior publication in the *Architectoni.ca* journal © CCAAS is made explicit;

Any commercial use of an article, *such as commercial distribution by any third party (with the exceptions specified above), and distribution to the commercial benefit of an author*, all require the author to obtain written permission from CCAAS.
